- Watches, pocket squares and tie pins are needed for the purpose of adding details or nice accessories



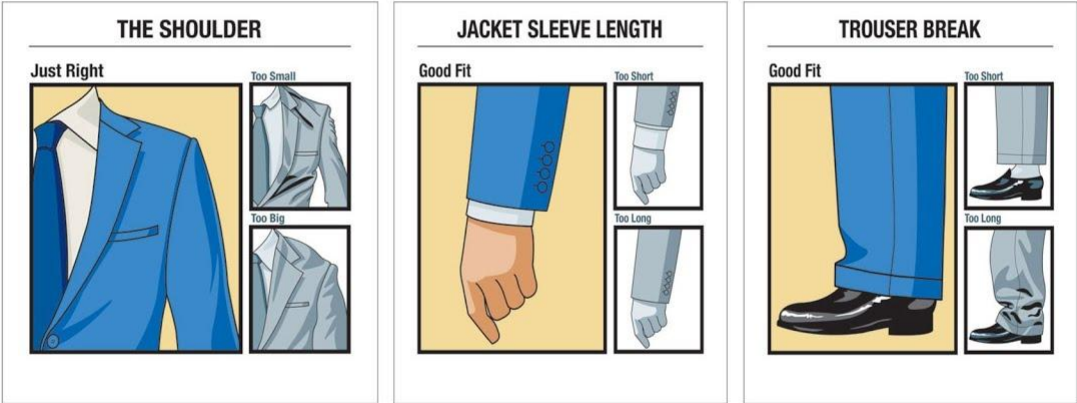




Not all suits are worth your money hence it is recommended to buy the following suit colors and choose wisely:
